### **Bean Road/North Road Cycle Route Connectivity, Hertford.**

The Integrated Transport Projects team of Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) has been developing proposals to enhance pedestrian and cycling facilities on North Road, Beane Road, Hertford North Station surrounds, Port Hill and Hartham Common. There are existing on road advisory cycle lanes and shared use paths within the study area and this scheme will enhance connectivity to town centre, Hertford North Station and Hartham Common. The primary aim of the scheme is to provide accessibility for both cyclists and pedestrians. This will improve safety for vulnerable road users and promote sustainable travel.

The proposals can be viewed in greater detail on drawing HC G-I1801.55 01, enclosed with this letter. The key components are:

1. Widen and resurface the existing footway on the northeast side of the carriageway on North Road between Beane Road and North Road roundabouts.
2. Clear vegetation on River Beane Footpath and remove trees obstructing the footpath with localised footway widening.
3. Improve kerb alignment and new road marking on the southbound approach to the Beane Road / North Road A119 roundabout near the Hertford North Station to increase lane width and improve safety for cyclists.
4. New pedestrian refuge and improvements to the existing pedestrian and cyclist crossing facilities on Beane Road.
5. Localised carriageway widening on Beane Road at River Beane footpath to allow for pedestrian refuge and right turn pocket for cyclists.
6. Associated signing for cyclist and pedestrian wayfinding.
7. Improve cycle accessibility and connection through Port Hill residential access by way of footpath resurfacing and changes to bollards.
8. Resurface and refresh road markings on North Road in 2019/2020 by HCC Maintenance team.

Based on the results of this consultation and subject to funding, works are scheduled to be completed in 2018/2019 financial year, excluding maintenance works, note no. 8.
